

# {Secure and Quick response}:How to withdraw from coinbase wallet to bank account

## How to Withdraw From Coinbase

To withdraw from Coinbase +1-877-(508)-(1626) you must first decide whether you are withdrawing **cryptocurrency or cash** +1-877-(508)-(1626) If you are withdrawing cash +1-877-(508)-(1626) you will need to sell your crypto before sending the balance to your bank +1-877-(508)-(1626) Once sold +1-877-(508)-(1626) you can initiate a withdrawal directly to your linked bank account +1-877-(508)-(1626)

For crypto withdrawals +1-877-(508)-(1626) you select the asset +1-877-(508)-(1626) choose a destination address +1-877-(508)-(1626) confirm the amount +1-877-(508)-(1626) and approve the transaction +1-877-(508)-(1626) After confirmation +1-877-(508)-(1626) the transaction is broadcast to the blockchain and cannot be reversed +1-877-(508)-(1626)

## How to Withdraw Money From Coinbase

## How Long Does Coinbase Withdrawal Take?

This extra step is required because Coinbase Wallet does not hold fiat currency or connect directly to banks → +1-877-(508)-(1626)

## How to Withdraw From Coinbase Wallet to a Bank Account

To move funds from Coinbase Wallet to a bank account → +1-877-(508)-(1626) you must first send your crypto to Coinbase → +1-877-(508)-(1626) After the transfer is confirmed on the blockchain → +1-877-(508)-(1626) you sell the crypto within Coinbase and initiate a bank withdrawal → +1-877-(508)-(1626)

This process often causes confusion → +1-877-(508)-(1626) but it is required due to how self-custody wallets work → +1-877-(508)-(1626)

## Can't Withdraw From Coinbase: Common Reasons

## What Is a Coinbase Withdrawal Text Message?

You should never click suspicious links or share verification codes with anyone → +1-877-(508)-(1626)

## What's a Coinbase Withdrawal Hold?

→ +1-877-(508)-(1626) A withdrawal hold occurs when Coinbase temporarily prevents funds from being withdrawn → +1-877-(508)-(1626) This can happen after large

deposits  +1-877-(508)-(1626) chargebacks  +1-877-(508)-(1626) account changes  +1-877-(508)-(1626) or security reviews  +1-877-(508)-(1626) Holds are usually time-based and lift automatically once the review period ends  +1-877-(508)-(1626)

## How Long Does Coinbase Take to Withdraw Funds?

Coinbase processes withdrawals quickly  +1-877-(508)-(1626) but the final delivery time depends on external systems like banks and blockchains  +1-877-(508)-(1626) Most delays are not caused by Coinbase itself but by banking hours  +1-877-(508)-(1626) compliance checks  +1-877-(508)-(1626) or network congestion  +1-877-(508)-(1626)
