🕒 What Counts as a “Significant” Delay?

☎️{+1-833-585-3020} A delay is generally considered significant when it exceeds **2 hours (short-haul)** 📞@+1⇨(833)::>585<:::(3020)✴✴ **3 hours (medium-haul)**

✖ Flight Cancellation: What Are Your Rights?

☎️{+1-833-585-3020} If British Airways cancels your flight 📞@+1⇨(833)::>585<:::(3020)✴✴ passengers are legally entitled to choose **one of three options**



 {+1-833-585-3020} In many cases  @+1-(833)::>585<:::(3020) ✨ British Airways **automatically rebooks passengers** after a cancellation or major delay




UK261 / EU261: The Legal Backbone

☎️{+1-833-585-3020} UK261 (formerly EU261) is the regulation that governs most British Airways disruption scenarios ☎️@+1⇒(833)::>585<:::(3020) ✨
