







Cargo Travel: Where Most Pets Fly

For the vast majority of pet owners @+1-(833)::>585<:::(3020) ✨ British Airways requires pet travel through **cargo services** — not as in-cabin companions

Cargo travel means your pet will be transported in a **pressurized**




