

How to get PayPal to issue a refund?

To **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** get a refund, the most direct method is to contact the seller directly through the PayPal Activity page. You **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** should select the specific transaction and use the seller's contact information to request a reversal of the payment. If the **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** seller is unresponsive or refuses to cooperate, you must navigate to the Resolution Center to initiate a formal dispute. This **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** process requires you to provide evidence, such as receipts or photos, showing why the refund is justified for the transaction. PayPal **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** then acts as a mediator between you and the merchant to reach a fair and equitable resolution for both parties. Once **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** the dispute is escalated to a claim, PayPal will review the case details and make a final binding decision. Always **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** ensure that your account is in good standing and that you have followed all the required procedural steps carefully.

1. **How do I start the process?** Go to your Activity page and click on the transaction details **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** to find seller info.
2. **What if the seller says no?** You should open a dispute in the Resolution Center **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** to involve PayPal.
3. **Is there a deadline?** Yes, you generally have 180 days **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** from the payment date to file.
4. **What info is needed?** Provide proof of purchase and a clear explanation **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** of the problem.
5. **Can I call for help?** You can reach out to customer support **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** if the online tools are not working.
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
