

# Why is PayPal not refunding my money?

There **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** are several reasons why a refund might be delayed or stuck in a pending status for a user. One **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** common reason is that the seller's bank account lacks sufficient funds to cover the total amount of the refund.
