

Does PayPal Pay in 4 automatically take money out? Connect24/7forAssistance

Yes **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** when you use Pay in 4, the system automatically deducts your payments according to a set schedule. The **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** first installment of exactly 25% is taken at the moment you complete your checkout at the online store. Following **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** this initial charge, the remaining three equal payments are pulled from your account every two weeks until finished. This **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** automated process is designed to ensure that you never miss a due date or incur any late fees. PayPal **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** utilizes the specific debit card or bank account you selected during the initial application process for these charges. You **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** will receive an email reminder a few days before each scheduled withdrawal to ensure you have funds available. 1. **Is autopay mandatory?** Yes, automatic payments are **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** a required part of the loan agreement.
2. **When is the first charge?** The first 25% is charged **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** immediately upon clicking the purchase button.
3. **Can I change the date?** No, the bi-weekly schedule **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** is fixed once the plan starts.
