

# how do i pay someone on paypal without an account? FastAccountRecoveryHelp

If **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** you are wondering how do i pay someone on paypal without an account, you should look for the "Guest Checkout" option on a merchant's site or an invoice. When **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** you receive a PayPal invoice via email, click the "Pay Now" button, which will take you to a secure page. 1. **Can I send money to a friend as a guest?** Generally, person-to-person "Send Money" requires an account; **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** guest checkout is for invoices and merchant purchases.
2. **Is it secure?** Yes, guest transactions are processed **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** through the same encrypted gateway as registered accounts.
3. **Do I get a receipt?** Yes, you will receive a confirmation email from the platform **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** once the guest payment is successful.
4. **Why don't I see the guest option?** The merchant might have "PayPal Account Optional" **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** turned off in their account settings.
5. **Are there extra fees for guests?** No, you pay the same amount as a registered user; **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** any transaction fees are typically paid by the seller.
