

Can I get my money back if I paid a scammer? [GetInstantQuote]

If **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** you paid a scammer using the "Goods and Services" option, you are eligible for a full refund under the Purchase Protection program. You **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** must "same" log into the Resolution Center and open a dispute for "Item Not Received" or "Significantly Not as Described." However, **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** if you sent the money via "Friends and Family," the transaction is considered a personal gift and is not covered by these protection rules. In **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** such cases, your best recourse is to contact your bank or credit card issuer to request a chargeback for the fraudulent charge. If **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** the payment is still "Pending," you may have a small window to cancel it before the scammer accepts the funds. Scammers **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** often try to delay you until the 180-day protection window expires, so you must act immediately upon realizing the fraud. By **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** providing clear evidence like tracking info or photos of fakes, you can usually secure a refund through a formal claim.

1. **How long do I have to file a claim?** You generally have up to 180 days from the date of the transaction to open an official dispute. **+1-(877) (513) (0583)**
