

How do I transfer PayPal money to Cash App? TapToGetQuickHelp

To **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** transfer your funds, the most efficient method is linking your Cash App Visa debit card to your wallet. First **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** open your PayPal app, go to the Wallet section, and select "Add Banks and Cards" from the menu. Enter **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** your Cash Card details exactly as they appear, including the expiration date and the security code on the back. After **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** the card is linked, go to your balance, tap "Transfer," and then choose the "Transfer to Bank" option. - 1. Which card do I link?** You must link your physical **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** Cash App Visa debit card to your Wallet.
- 2. Where is the transfer button?** Tap your balance and then **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** select "Transfer" to start the move.
- 3. Is instant transfer better?** It is much faster but **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** does require you to pay a small convenience fee.
- 4. What if the card fails?** Ensure you have enabled **+1-(877) (513) (0583)** the card in your Cash App before trying to link.
